Types of caps that we accept for the Bottle-Caps-to-Benches Project

Caps: SORTED, WASHED, CLEANED AND DRIED

Medicine Bottle Caps & Medicine Bottles (2,4,5 with label removed) No cardboard inserts in lids.	Drink Bottle Caps Soda, water, juice and sports drinks
Milk Jug Caps	Flip-top caps (ie: Ketchup, Mustard, Creamer tops)
Detergent Caps	Spout caps (ie: Mustard tops)
Hair Spray Caps	Spray Paint Caps
Toothpaste Tube Caps	Ointment Tube Caps
Deodorant Caps	Baby Food Caps
Apple Sauce Pouch Caps	Shampoo/Conditioner Caps

Lids: SORTED, WASHED AND CLEANED

Cottage Cheese Container Lids	Cool Whip Container Lids
Mayonnaise Jar Lids	Coffee Can Lids
Yogurt Lids	Cream Cheese Container Lids
