**Important**

There are a couple of changes for the registration process for the 2019-2020 school year. These changes were listed on the "Tuition and Fees Schedule" that came home a few months ago, but there are a couple of key points in case you did not see them.

The School Committee decided that all families must use FACTS next year unless you are paying in full. Please note that FACTS agreements are starting and ending a month earlier for next year (July-April), so please make sure you are signed up by the end of June if you would like tuition spread over a full 10 months. You may register later, but if it is not activated in time for the July payment, your tuition will be spread over 9 months instead of 10, or the first month will be paid in advance in the office. If you used FACTS for 2018-2019, you will be rolled over automatically. If you have never used it, OR if you used it in a prior year but not this year, you will need to create a new agreement using the link above.

Fees for using FACTS (charged by FACTS, payable to the office) are as follows:

- \$50 annually for 3 or more payments (this option for 10-month payers)
- \$10 annually for 2 payments (this option for 2-semester payers. The dates for payment are 7/10/19 and 12/10/19)


